



Call for Teachers – On-line Tutoring Initiative

In an attempt to help students who want to improve their English, the Ministry of Education has initiated an on-line learning support center. The service is free of charge and is offered to students who are in the 10th-12th grades.

The support center will offer different options of helping the students:

1. Instant support – Students can be helped immediately when encountering problems involving homework or preparation for exams.
2. Private lesson – These lessons are pre-scheduled by the student asking for help in a specific area e.g. writing compositions.
3. Private group lesson – These lessons deal with a shared problem or specific area that is giving them difficulty.
4. Intensive group "marathons"- Before Bagrut exams for example.

We invite you, English teachers who have been preparing students for Bagrut exams (3-4-5 points) during the past four years or more, to become part of team of teachers who will be giving on-line support to students. This is indeed a very special opportunity to be part of this groundbreaking project.

Additional information:

- Tutoring will take place on-line between 16:00-20:00 (a teacher may choose to take only half of this shift).
- A teacher has to commit her/himself for at least two days a week.
- The following equipment is necessary for participating in the project: Wifi, headphones, microphone, webcam.
