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## Fact File About a Famous Rabbi

Read the information about a famous rabbi.

### Rabbi Yosef Caro

#### **SCHULCHAN ARUCH**

Rabbi Yosef ben Ephraim Caro was born in Toledo, Spain in 1488 and died in Safed in 1575. He is also called *Maran* ("our master") or *Ha-Mechaber* ("the author,"). Rabbi Caro left Spain in 1492 and moved with his family to Turkey. In 1536, he moved again and this time to *Eretz Yisrael*. Rabbi Caro became the chief rabbi of *Safed*. Rabbi Caro was the author of the *Beit Yosef* and then he wrote the *Shulchan Aruch*. Also Rabbi Caro wrote the *Kesef Mishneh* on the Rambam's *Mishneh Torah*.
