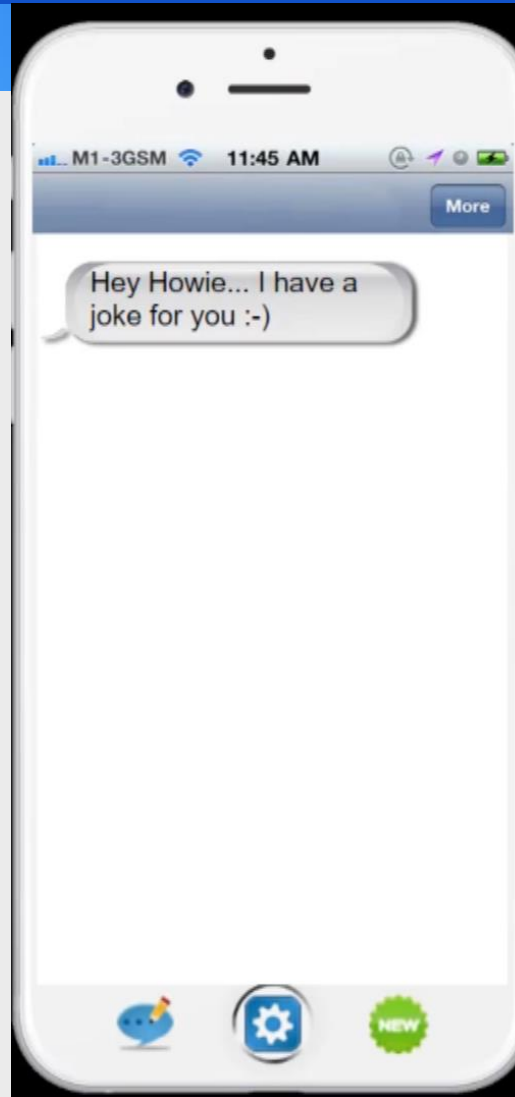
# ■ Fun is Funny

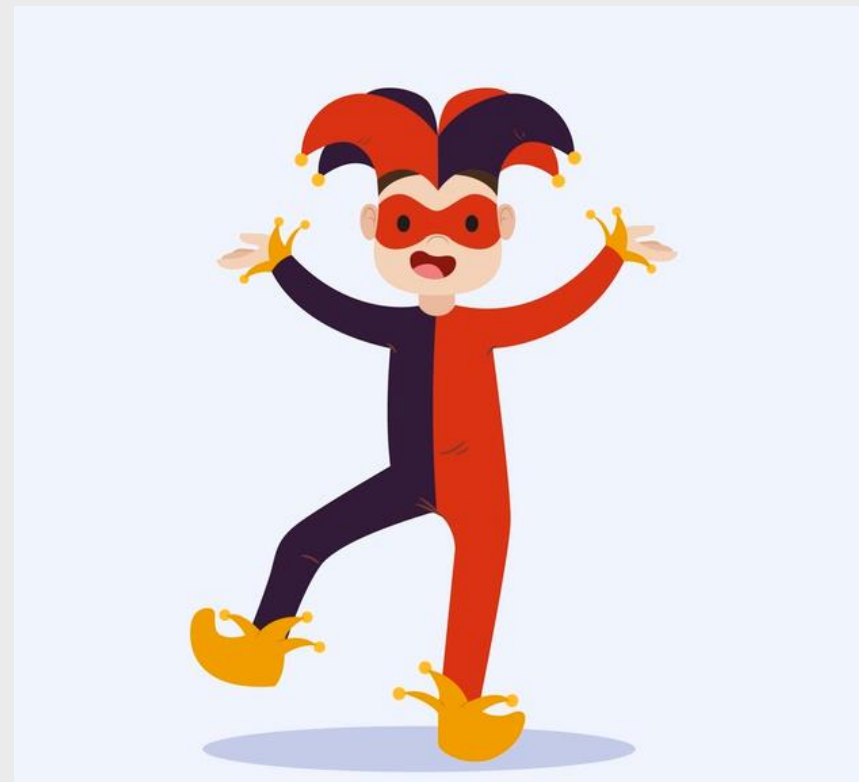

# History of Humour



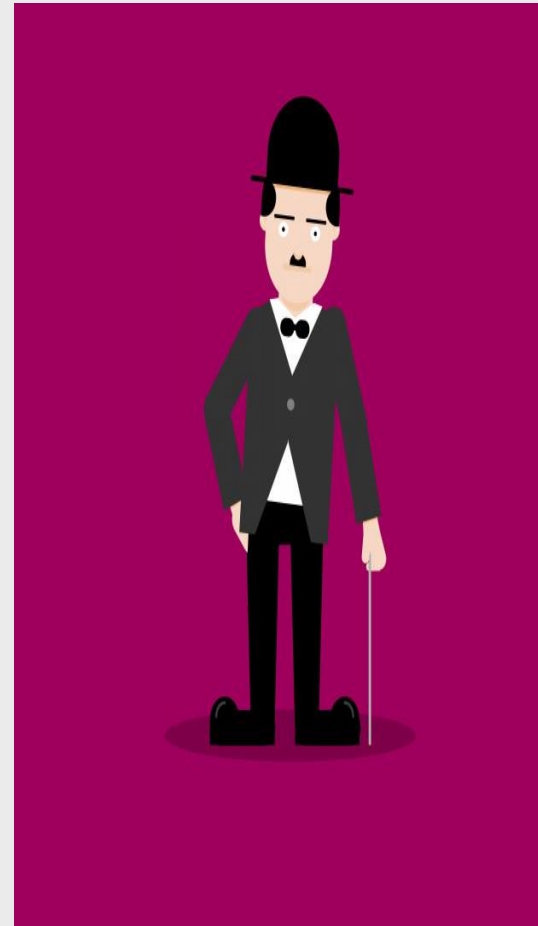
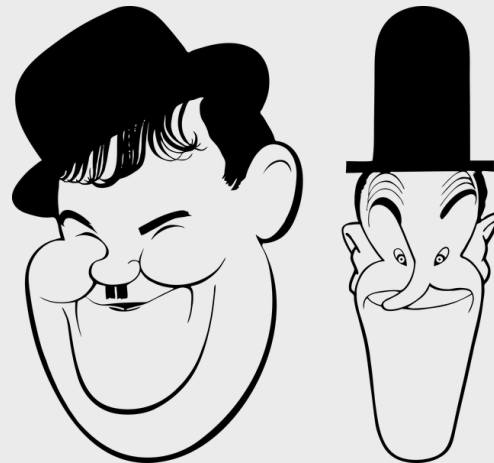
For many years people of all ages and cultures respond to humour. That means that the smile or laugh at a joke or something funny.

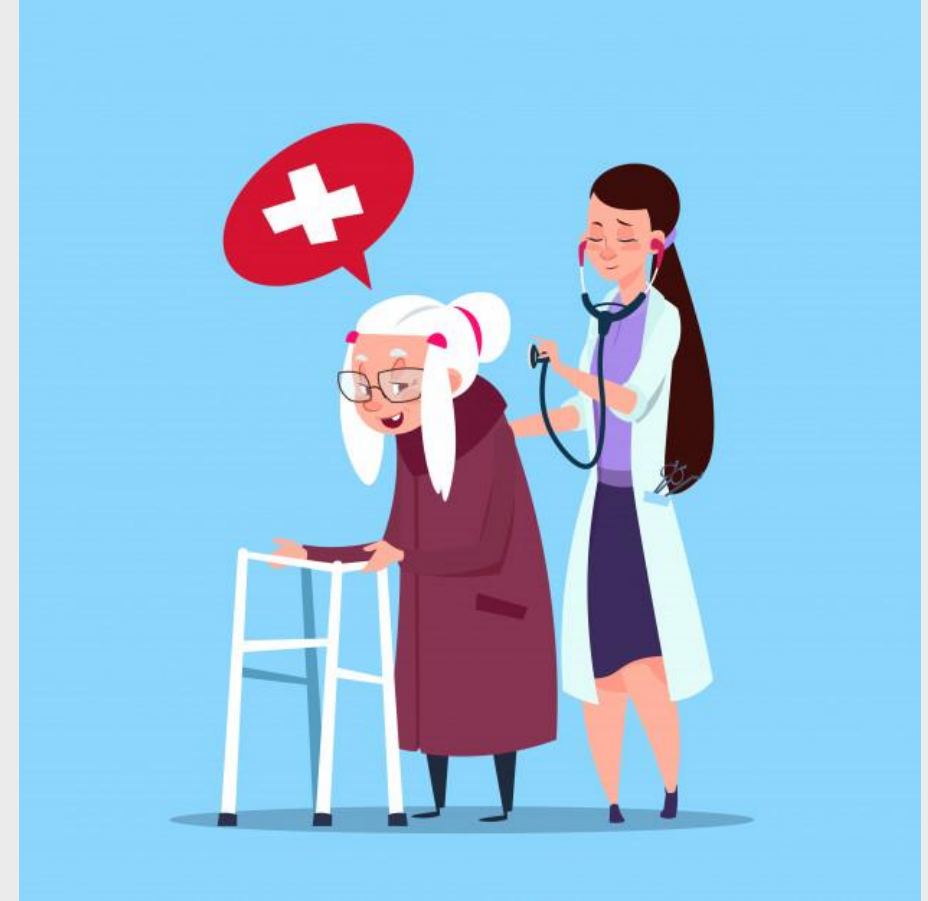
