■ A Fact



A **fact** is true and correct, no matter what.



Finding Facts



We can find facts by:

- doing research
- looking up information on the Internet



■ Example for Facts



For example:

- A dog is an animal.



- Orange is a color.



An Opinion



An **opinion** is a statement that describes how someone thinks or feels.



■ Example for Opinions



For example:

- Dogs are good pets.



- I like oranges.

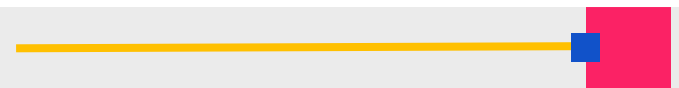

It is called the cocoa bean.



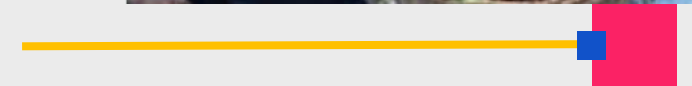
Chocolate

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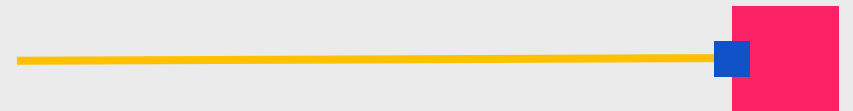
