Prof. Philip D. Jaffé, director of the Interfaculty Center for the Rights of the Child at the University of Geneva and member of the IDE Board of Trustees. He was elected in New York on June 29, 2018 as a member to the UN Committee on the Rights of the Child.

Philip D. Jaffé, a Full Professor and Director of The Centre for Children's Rights Studies - (CIDE), trained in clinical psychology at the University of Fribourg, Geneva (Diploma, 1983) and, thanks to a grant from the FNRS, at Yeshiva University (Ph.D. 1988) in New York. After postdoctoral work at Harvard University (McLean Hospital), he trained in forensic psychology and worked for several years in the Massachusetts penitentiary system. Since returning to Switzerland, he has taught clinical psychology and forensic psychology at the University of Geneva and developed a private practice as a psychotherapist and court expert. He co-founded, and for ten years chaired, the Swiss Society of Forensic Psychology. He is also responsible for the Children and Youth Policy component of the Swiss Center for Competence for Human Rights (CSDH). His areas of academic and professional interest have long been focused on the protection of children, particularly with regard to sexual abuse and the position of children in the civil and criminal justice system. Philip D. Jaffé is a member of the FDI Foundation Board.
