Guidelines for the Shortened Oral Examination 91381

General Directions:

1. The exam must be administered **ONLY** by an approved Diplomacy bagrut marker who is not currently instructing the student in any class. The marker was assigned by the National Diplomacy and International Communications counsellor to be an examiner.
2. The students are eligible to 15-20 minutes for preparation for the testing before the testing session begins. Students who do not benefit from this may begin the test without the preparation time.

Following are the specific guidelines and instructions for the testing process:

Section 1: Questions 1-6

Read questions 1-6 to the student. The student may request to have short sections of the speech read aloud, but not the entire speech, as they received the speech before the exam and had time to prepare.

Ask the student to choose THREE of the six questions to answer orally.

Section 2: Questions 7 and 8

1. Read the "Note" at the beginning of the article and then **lines 1-24 and 43-81** from the article.
2. Read **question 7 - DEPP**
 - Ask student to complete the **DEFINE** and **PRESCRIBE** of the DEPP (sections **a and d**).
3. Read **question 8 - STAKEHOLDERS**
 - Ask student to identify and justify TWO of the stakeholders (sections **a and b**).

Section 3: Question 9

Read the TOPICS for the SEET composition to the student.

Ask the student to write or dictate a partial SEET composition for ONE of the topics, that includes:

- **STATEMENT**
- **ONE EXPLANATION + ONE EXAMPLE**
- **COUNTERARGUMENT + REBUTTAL**

Following the examination, the examiner is responsible for evaluating and grading the examination. The answer key will be available after 5 PM.
