- Present a United Nations Sustainable Development Goal,
- Analyze and synthesize info about entrepreneurs,
- Pitch an Israeli Start-up,
- Argue convincingly for your position on business fraud.

Course Learning Outcomes

Students who successfully complete this course will be able to...

- Write a summary paragraph distilling essential info from a source,
- Synthesize several written and oral sources in writing and speaking,
- Write a 3-paragraph position paper,
- Deliver formal and informal presentations using visual aids,
- Reference and build on academic and professional sources in writing and speaking.

Adjustments to be made for high school teaching:

- The course is taught over a six-month period (approx. double the number of hours at university).
- The course is adapted to high school students.
- Course Instructors are the English teachers at the school, who will be key partners in making lessons accessible to students.
- Open University staff provides academic and pedagogic guidance of the teaching and learning.


