

COBE iTest: PRACTICE TESTS AND SIMULATIONS (MOCK EXAMS)

Running a simulation (“mock” test) at your school.

SIMULATIONS (“mock” tests / hadmayot) are an important part of preparing your students for the COBE. The simulation **must be downloaded on the day you intend to implement it at your school.**

*NOTE: Links to the clips are from the **original sources**. The final versions that appear on practice tests, simulations, and exams have been edited to be completely appropriate for students. Copyright restrictions prevent posting edited versions of clips in public forums.*

The simulation is the ONLY opportunity for a complete technical and administrative “run-through” with the iTest system where students can log in to the exam, take an actual test and submit it to the *matach* server to see that everything is working properly and to minimize stress and confusion on testing days.

NOTE! - Simulations will NOT be available after 12/3/23 (48 hours before the first exam date in accordance with Testing Department policy).

- **Simulations can not be implemented on an iTEST EXAM DATE.**

Practice Tests (‘tirgulum’) can be downloaded and used any time for practice, assessment, or matconot. The filenames for these tests have “**tir**” in the filename and can be used on any day. (Note: tests cannot be downloaded from the iTest system on a national test date).

BOTH simulation AND practice tests allow students to record their answers, which can then be downloaded, saved and graded.
