**PART I: ACCESS TO INFORMATION FROM WRITTEN TEXTS (100 points)**

**SHOULD DRIVERS CONTINUE TO TALK ON A CELL PHONE WHILE DRIVING?**

**General comment: For misuse of pronoun, deduct 1 pt only ONCE per question. However, accept if the pronoun is used appropriately with quotation marks.**

1.	The driver doesn't / Drivers don't have enough control over the car. <i>If copy from lines 1-2 "... driving with only one hand... control over the car" – accept.</i> <i>If copy only: "(Everyone knows that) driving with only one hand on the steering-wheel is dangerous" – deduct 4 pts (C3).</i> <i>If copy from lines 2-4 "... many countries made it illegal... that they hold in their hand – 0.</i> <i>If write: "Drivers have more accidents" – deduct 4 pts (C3).</i>	8
2.	<u>One</u> of the following: (1) Their mind is distracted. (2) They don't pay attention to the road. <i>If write (1) and (2) together – accept.</i>	9
3.	(1) [ <b>One group</b> ] talked on the cell phone. (2) [ <b>The other group</b> ] talked to a passenger (in the car).	2×8=16
4.	iii) participants in the study had to do [VB: ii]	9
5.	ii) how safely the participants were driving [VB: i] v) how long it took drivers to react to road problems [VB: iv]	2×8=16
6.	i) It is more distracting than talking to a passenger. [VB: ii]	8
7.	They looked straight ahead without checking the mirrors. // They didn't check the mirrors. <i>If write only: "They looked straight ahead" – deduct 3 pts (C3).</i> <i>If write: "They were less aware of what was happening around them" and / or "reacted slowly to problems on the road" – 0.</i>	8
8.	i) drives have changed their habits in the past. [VB iii]	9
9.	iii) Using a cell phone while driving. [VB iv]	9
10.	ii) Using a cell phone while driving is always dangerous. [VB iii]	8
