CAROL'S ADVICE COLUMN

General comment: For misuse of pronoun, deduct 1 pt only ONCE per question. However, accept if the pronoun is used appropriately with quotation marks.

2.	i) to give an example of his problem [VB ii]	9
3.	[He] (often) gets angry (with his friends and family). If write: [He] "(sometimes) falls asleep <u>in class / in the movies</u> " – accept. <i>If write only: falls asleep – 0.</i> <i>If write: [He] "goes to the doctor" – 0.</i> <i>If write: [He] "(When I'm tired) I often get angry (with my friends and family)" or [He] "(sometimes) I fall asleep in class" – deduct 4 pts for ignoring the stem.</i>	9
4.	ii) seven hours of sleep are not enough [VB iii]	8
5.	i) it is difficult for teenagers to get enough sleep [VB ii]	9
6.	1) [Nick should] <i>One of the following:</i> (1) do something relaxing (before he goes to bed) (2) read a book (3) take a warm shower <i>If write: "do something relaxing – read a book / take a warm shower" – accept.</i> <i>If write: [Nick should] "If you have trouble falling asleep, do something relaxing before you go to bed" – deduct 4 pts for ignoring the stem.</i> <i>If write: "go to sleep earlier" – 0 (We asked what he should do <u>before going to sleep</u>).</i> 2) [Nick should not] <i>One of the following:</i> (1) watch TV (2) use his / a computer (3) drink (a lot of) cola (and other drinks that have caffeine in them). <i>If write: [Nick should not] "don't watch TV (or use your computer)" – deduct 4 pts for ignoring the stem.</i> <i>General comments:</i> <i>If verb is missing in both (1) and (2) – deduct 3 pts only once (–1 for Language and –2 for C3), as in the examples: (1) "Nick should warm shower" (2) "Nick should not (a lot of) cola".</i> <i>If ignore the stem in both (1) and (2) – deduct 4 pts. only once.</i>	2×9=18
7.	(To) start the school day (one hour) later (in the morning). <i>If write: To help their students, they start the school day one hour later in the morning – deduct 2 pts.</i> <i>If write: "(To) help the / their students" – deduct 3 pts.</i> <i>If write: "agree to do the same" – 0.</i>	9
