**GENERAL COMMENTS:**

1. Markers can give in-between grades e.g. 9 pts.

3. If the student does not write a thank you letter but writes a letter or a description of what he got / bought for his birthday and / or a description of his birthday – accept.
4. If student writes thank you letter without relating to the bullets – accept.
5. If student doesn't write in the past tense – accept.
6. If student lives in England – accept.
7. If student misunderstands and writes as the uncle or if writes to a friend instead of to his uncle – deduct 5 pts. from content.
