Fast Fashion Teenagers usually love to go shopping for clothes. Companies convince us to buy clothes that we don't really need so we buy affordable and trendy clothes. This is called Fast fashion. The world consumes<sup>1</sup> 80 billion pieces of new clothing each year. On average<sup>2</sup> we wear fast fashion garments<sup>3</sup> less than five times and keep them for 35 days. Our constant need for new things has changed our outlook on clothes. We no longer buy quality garments but instead buy disposable<sup>4</sup> items which we replace next month.

# Did you know?

1. The clothing industry causes a lot of pollution<sup>5</sup>: it is the second highest pollutant of clean water.

2. It takes 2,700 liters of water to make just one T-shirt.

3. On average people only wear 20% of the clothes they buy.

4. Each American throws to the garbage each year 37 KG. of textile waste<sup>6</sup>. This waste sits in landfills 200 years and releases<sup>7</sup> harmful gases to the environment.

5. Garment factories are opened in developing countries<sup>8</sup> where they use very cheap labor<sup>9</sup>.

6. Coal burned to operate those factories pollutes the air and the toxic waste is created which pollutes the rivers.

7. The most commonly used fiber<sup>10</sup> in our clothing is polyester. It is a synthetic fiber that can take hundreds of years to break down.

## What can we do?

1. We can be more conscious<sup>11</sup> about where our clothes come from, how they are made and where they end up.

2. We can donate<sup>12</sup> clothes, or exchange them.

3. We can use our clothes much more and buy less.
