Good Deeds (מעשים) Day

Good Deeds Day is an annual (שנתית) tradition which takes place all over the world in 75 countries. Thousands of people choose to give their time in order to volunteer and help others. The idea behind Good Deeds Day is that every single person can do something good, be it large or small, to improve (לשפר) the lives of others and positively change the world. Shari Arison, businesswoman and philanthropist (נדבנית) initiated (יזמה) Good Deeds Day.

Good deeds you can do:

1. Visit a sick friend.
2. Give food to a homeless person in the street.
2. Bring something to share at school.
4. Clean up garbage in your neighborhood/yard/beach/park.
5. Visit elderly people in an old age home.
6. Volunteer in an organization that helps the needy (נדקקים) or collects food for them.
7. Help your friends in school who are having difficulties in doing their homework.
8. Become friends with a student who is lonely.
