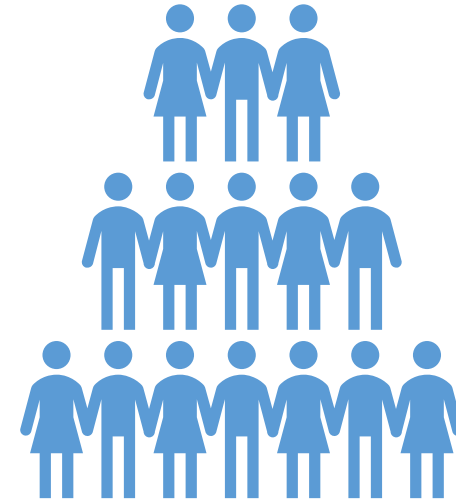

To delete a group, click on it and select "Delete selected group".

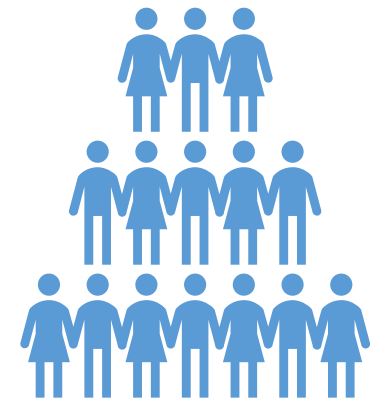
Now our groups are ready, and we can use them to allow different types of access to activities.

- 2) an **entire unit** in our course


1) Allowing access to a specific activity



To allow access to a specific activity, we have to be in 'Edit' mode. Go to the activity, activate the 'Edit' mode and then click "Settings" from the activity page.



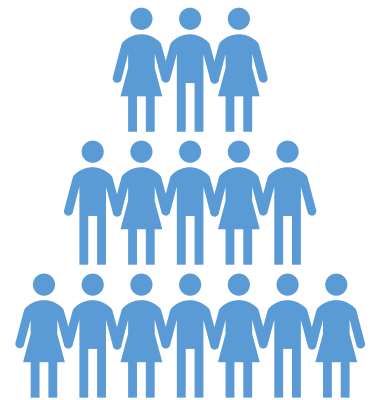

2) Allowing access to an entire unit



To restrict an entire unit, turn on the 'Edit' mode. Scroll down to the desired unit and click 'Edit tile' from the right side of the unit menu.


