

# "Dig into Digital"

What to do when a video doesn't work or isn't culturally suitable for your students.

**When the video in the course doesn't work, you need to do the following:**

**1. Hide the activity where the video doesn't work.**

**2. Add a new activity with another video and new tasks.**

# To hide the activity, follow the following steps:

1. Choose the course you want to edit.

2. On the course's home page, you will find the units, displayed in Tiles format

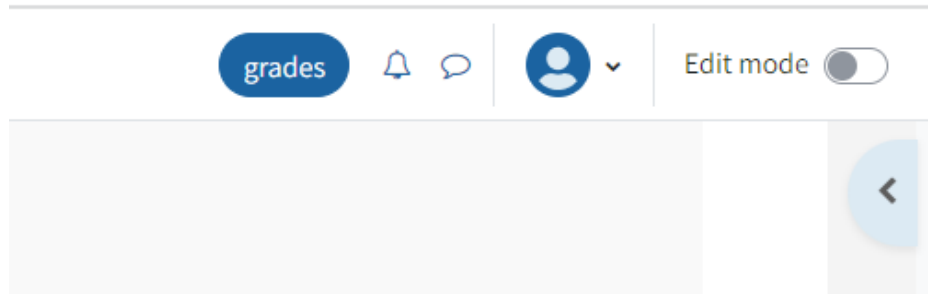

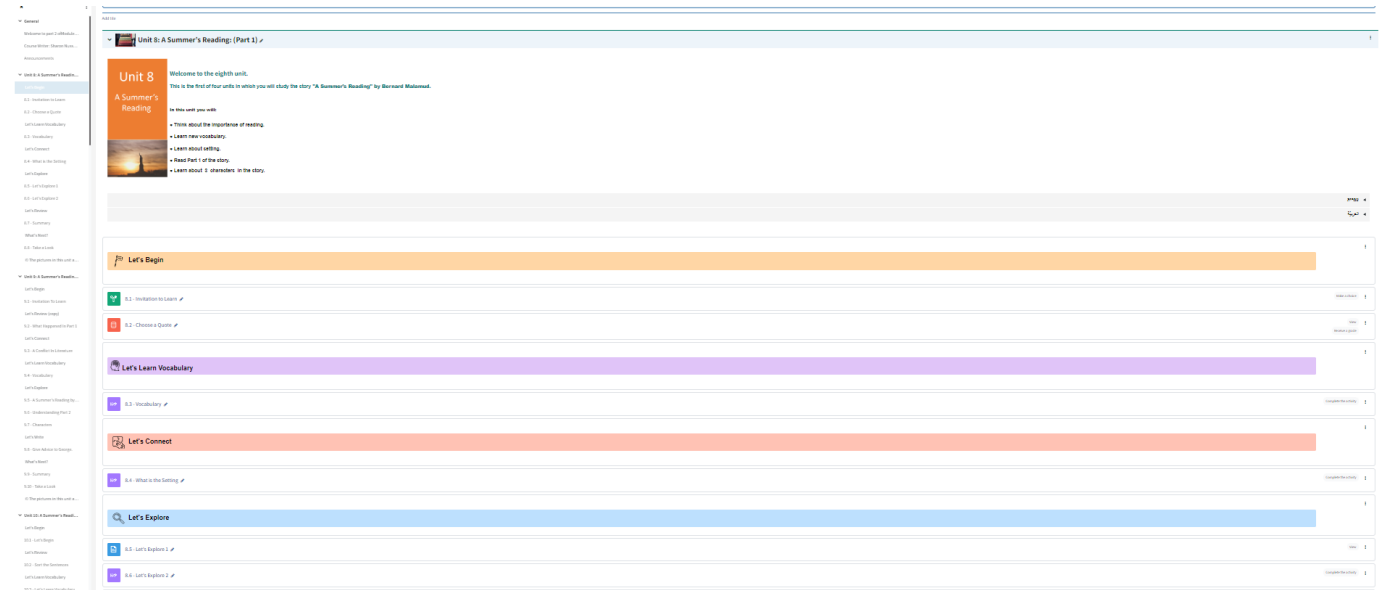

**Click on the "edit mode" button in the top right-hand corner.**


**The course view will change, and units will appear as a list.**

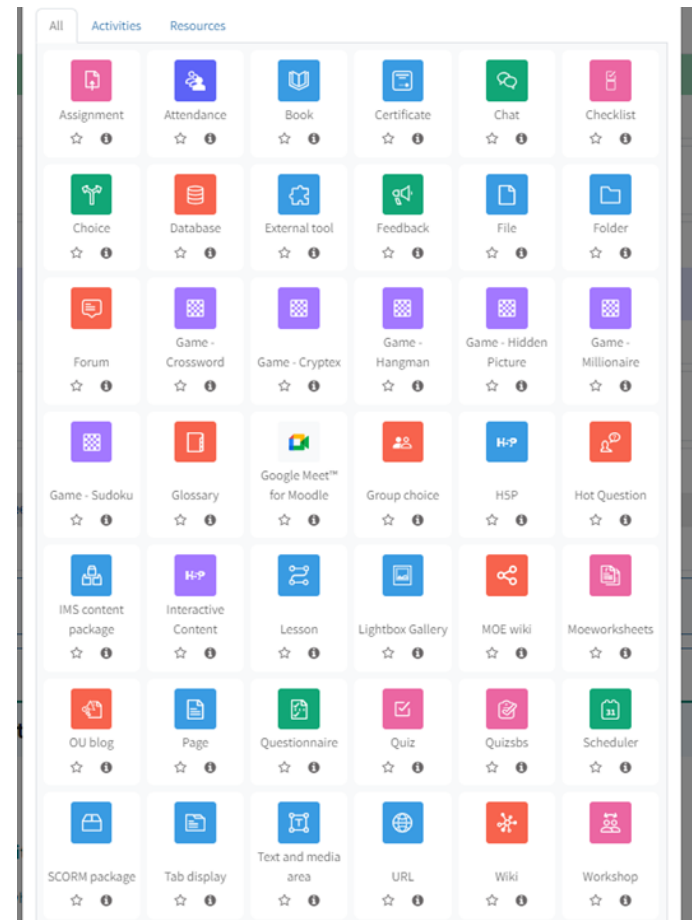

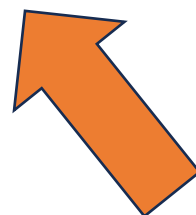
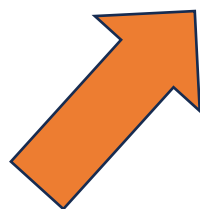
