Dear English Teachers,

Welcome to the second issue of our newsletter for this school year. The Ministry of Education recently published Bagrut data and statistics from תש"ף 2020. The data displays encouraging results for English. For example, there is a constant increase in the number of students taking the 5-point exam (from 32% in 2016 to 41.5% in 2020). In addition, there has been an increase in the number of students who have taken the Bagrut in English and fewer 3 pointers.

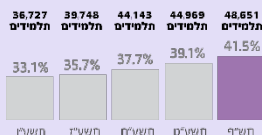

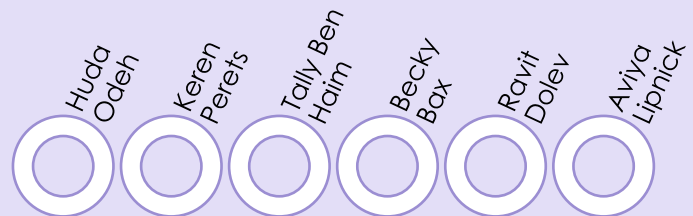
## [The Voices Israel Group of Poets in English Announces the Third Bar Sagi Young Poets Prize Competition, 2022](#)

Please browse all the information. Schools have begun to register and the competition is in motion. Make sure you follow the guidelines as we cannot accept late entries.

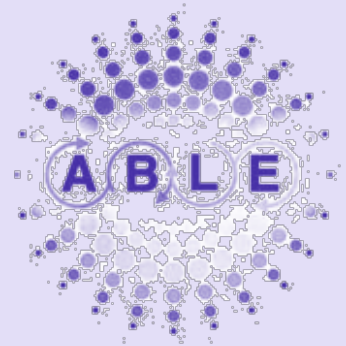

## Visit the Site for Diplomacy and International Communication in English!

Debating Matters to Us is the high school debate tournament in English, hosted by Diplomacy schools and teachers, but open to all, and we invite you to join us with your English class!

Each tournament will consist of 6-12 schools. In each room there will be three schools and three rounds, where each school debates against the other two. The school is also asked to bring along a student to serve as a debate chairperson, and one to be a timekeeper. The rest of the class supports and participates in the audience, with time in the debate allotted to their questions and challenges.

Our format, while giving students an authentic opportunity to use English, puts more of an emphasis on content than accuracy of language. Debating Matters to Us is a fun, non-threatening way to let your students shine and express themselves, and everyone's a winner, whether or not they win their debate. 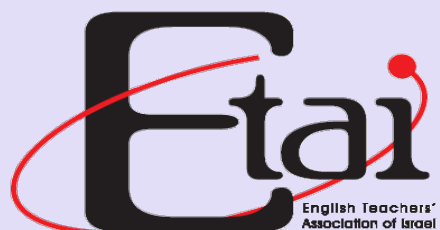
## TEACHER CHAT & CHAT AWAY

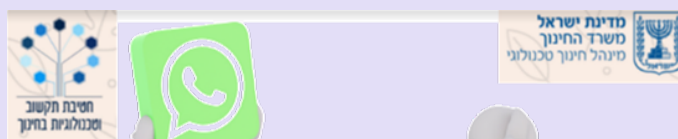
