

Special Education Students and the Oral Bagrut Examination

The following information is relevant and updated for the Summer 2022 Moed ONLY!

Who are Special Ed. Students?

- Students in special education schools
- Students in special education classes in regular schools
- Students identified as 07, 08, 01 in regular classes
- Students diagnosed as being hard of hearing, having a visual impairment, or being on the autism spectrum

Who must take an Oral Bagrut Exam as of תשפ"ב?

<u>ALL STUDENTS</u> are required to take the Oral Bagrut Examination in order to complete the requirements for the English Bagrut.

WHO tests OBE students?

Due to ongoing COVID restrictions, students taking the OBE (f2f) in the SUMMER 2022 moed will be tested by English teachers at the students' own school.

- The bagrut secretary will match teacher to student on the shiluvit.
- Set a test date with the tester.
- School grades must be submitted prior to the exam date.
- The testers will be sent instructions for submitting grades via the MARVAD "app"

WHEN are OBE students tested?

> The date for testing is set by the school and the tester.

OBE students <u>DO NOT</u> have to be tested on the same day their peers are tested on the COBE.

Guidelines for students taking the OBE (16385, 16485, 16585)

- Students are permitted to take their project into the exam.
- No additional materials are permitted.

Guidelines for students who are being tested on the COBE

(16487, 16587, 16486, 16586)

- Students are not permitted to bring any materials into the exam
- TIME ACCOMMODATIONS in addition to the 30 minute allowance for the exam:

*DUE TO ONGOING COVID RESTRICTIONS, STUDENTS WILL BE ENTITLED TO THE FOLLOWING ACCOMMODATIONS FOR THE SUMMER 2022 MOED ONLY

- <u>ALL</u> students taking the COBE will have a 15% time extension for the exam. This amounts to an additional 4.5 minutes.
- All students who have time accommodations for all exams, will have these accommodations IN ADDITION to the 15%. (This will amount to a total of about 45 minutes for the exam).
