The BOOST: The **B**agrut **O**nline **O**ral **S**kills **T**est- a computerized oral Bagrut exam for three pointers will begin this year as a PILOT only. Next year, in the summer of 2024, it will become compulsory for all 12th grade 3-point students.

The BOOST has been carefully designed by a select committee whose members have a deep understanding of the challenges 3-point students face in all facets of EFL learning. Those of you who have seen the prototype of the BOOST at our district meetings will certainly agree that the exam is very "user-friendly" and SUCCESS-oriented. Success on the BOOST will promote an authentic sense of achievement among our students. All tasks are based on the Can-Do statements at the A2 level. Teachers and students alike will see the connection between what is taught and learned in class, and what is tested on the BOOST. In service courses, as well as hands on material and ongoing support to teachers, will be provided, to ensure that our 3-point students experience the joy of completing high school and are proud to have a Bagrut in English that represents true achievement!
