- 1 Technology has changed our lives in many ways. There have been many improvements in our homes, for example we can keep food in a fridge and cook a meal quickly in a microwave*. New inventions have also changed the types of jobs people do. There are many jobs that people did a hundred years ago that no longer exist. Here are three of them.

2 Lamp lighters

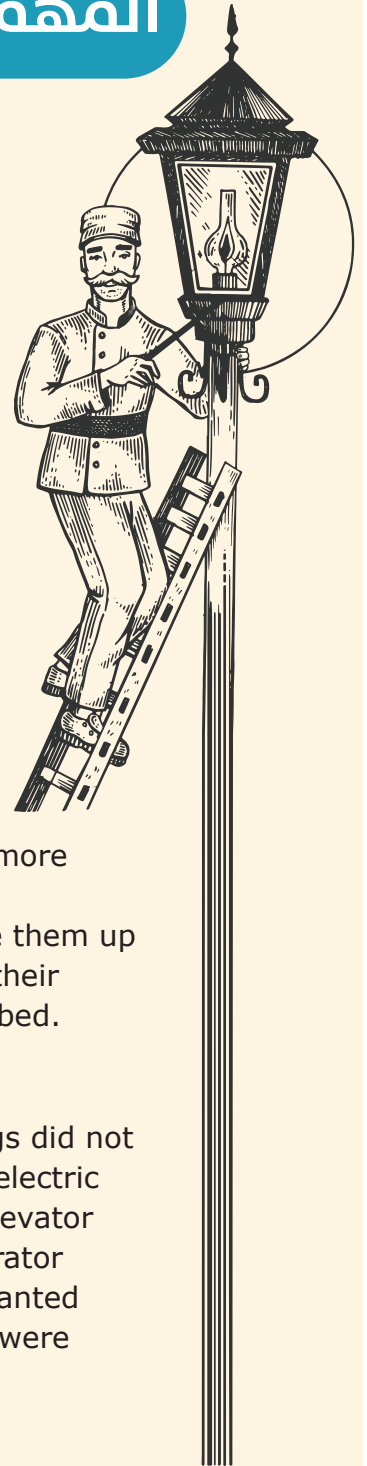
Before the invention of street lights, streets were dark and dangerous at night. The first street lights were invented about 200 years ago. They used gas, so they were not like the modern electric lights we use today. Every evening lamp lighters would light all the street lights, one by one, before it got dark. Then in the morning they would go round and turn each of them off.

3 Knocker-uppers

Most people find it hard to wake up in the morning. It was even more difficult in the past when there were no alarm clocks**. In those days, people paid money to someone to come and wake them up so they could get to work on time. The knocker-uppers came to their home and knocked on their door or window until they got out of bed.

4 Elevator operators

People get tired climbing stairs. That's why 150 years ago buildings did not have more than four floors. Taller buildings were built only after electric elevators were invented. In these early elevators there was an elevator operator who always traveled in it with the passengers. This operator controlled the speed of the elevator and stopped it where they wanted to get out. When the modern, automatic elevators we use today were invented, the job of the operator disappeared.

Does the world need zoos?

Dr. Peter Burrell, a member of the organization 'Close Zoos Now'

It is simple. All zoos should be closed down immediately. I know people
 5 enjoy visiting them, but watching animals suffer is not something we should find entertaining.

Just think about a zoo in a cold country. Many of its animals come
 10 from hot places and cannot adapt* to the changes in the weather. For example, when it is cold, giraffes can become ill and must be kept inside a building – not a good place for them
 15 to live in.

It is important to remember that animals are put in a small place and given their food in a zoo. In their natural habitat** they often have to
 20 travel over 100 kilometers to find food and water. This is a daily challenge. Without this difficulty of everyday life the animals don't have enough interesting things to do and become
 25 bored and lazy.

Also, many animals, such as zebras, live in large groups in their natural habitat. Unfortunately, in zoos they suffer because they are kept with
 30 only one or two other animals.

Of course, I realize that closing zoos means some endangered*** animals will become extinct****. But that is better than allowing them to live a
 35 terrible life in a zoo.

Dr. Jenny Miller, a scientist who works in a zoo

Zoos are important places, and are very popular too. It is lovely to see
 40 people of all ages get excited as they get close to wild animals, such as tigers, zebras, and monkeys. Indeed, zoos make it possible to see animals that most of us will never be
 45 able to visit in their natural habitats.

Many of the animals we look after in zoos, such as giraffes and some kinds of tigers, are endangered, and in their natural habitats could
 50 become extinct. In zoos, endangered animals have babies, and so they will never completely disappear from the world.

Studies show that many animals, including zebras and penguins, adapt very quickly to living in a zoo. But many other animals often have problems because they don't have enough interesting things to do. My
 55 job is to make sure that our animals don't become bored. For example, we know that monkeys seem much happier when we give them children's toys to play with.

I am sure that visitors would complain if they saw unhappy animals. Actually, in most zoos animals are looked after very well.

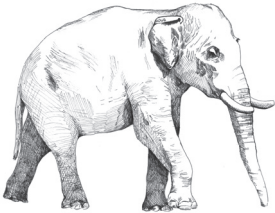
