The assessment tool includes six tasks as described in the table below:

Task 3: Vocabulary	Written Reception (vocabulary)
Task 4: The National Hat Museum	Written Reception (reading)
Task 5: Use your plate – then eat it!	Written Reception (reading)
Task 6: The Sucsess of Alice's Adventures in Wonderland	Written Reception (reading)

people laugh. I like those umbrellas best.

Interviewer: Oooh, can you give me an example of a joke that is on an umbrella?

Natalie: hmmm... Yes! I can give you an example: The question is: Why do

people carry umbrellas?

Interviewer: Why do people carry umbrellas?

Natalie: The answer is: because umbrellas can't walk!

Interviewer: Oh! That is funny! Are these funny umbrellas your most popular ones?

Natalie: No, they are not. Actually, the most popular umbrellas are the ones

that don't break when there is a strong wind.

Interviewer: I definitely want one of those. An umbrella that won't break when there

is a strong wind. That is really useful.
