# November 29, 1947 (Kaf Tet B'November)

The United Nations (UN) created a plan to partition the land of Israel into two independent states, one Jewish and one Arab, in 1947. A committee called UNSCOP was appointed by the UN General Assembly to gather information and make recommendations. UNSCOP traveled to Israel and also met with representatives of Arab countries and saw refugee camps in Europe. They recommended ending the British mandate in Palestine and partitioning the land into two states. The plan was accepted by the UN General Assembly, and this led to the declaration of the state of Israel.

In the past <u>November 29th</u> was a very happy day in Israel. Today, it became just another regular day.

# Declaration of Independence - Research Paper

On May 14th, 1948, the State of Israel was established as a sovereign nation. The declaration outlined the values and principles upon which the new country would be founded.





The Declaration of Independence was written by a group of Jewish leaders, including David Ben-Gurion, who later became the first Prime Minister of Israel. It was a statement of the Jewish people's right to self-determination and their desire to establish a homeland in their ancient land of Israel.

The Declaration emphasized the values of democracy, equality, and justice, and stated that the new state would be open to all its citizens, regardless of religion, race, or ethnicity. It also outlined the rights and responsibilities of Israeli citizens, including the right to education, healthcare, and social security.



The Declaration of Independence was a significant moment in the history of Israel and the Jewish people. It marked the end of centuries of persecution and the beginning of a new chapter in the nation's history.
