

Diplomacy and International Communications in English

Bagrut Marker (מעריך)

Requirements:

1. Applicants must have taught the major for at least **four years** and, during this time, **taught all three years** of the major and submitted students for the bagrut.
2. The applicant's level of English must be at the native speaker level.
3. All applicants must be approved by a National Counselor for the major. This may be done by having a lesson observed.

Once these requirements are met, an application can be sent using the English Inspectorate's official website (teachers who meet the criteria and want to be Bagrut markers should apply on the [Expert's Site](#). Tutorial for Help with the Expert's Site (Marvad)

experts.education.gov.il. When you apply, please specify that you are applying for Diplomacy only. Diplomacy marking and English marking are separate subject areas, each with its own requirements. This document only pertains to Diplomacy.

If you would like to mark the English bagrut as well, you may do so if you are an English teacher and have all of the criteria/documents needed. A separate application is required for this.

Please note that there is a technical workshop that you are required to take in Lod, at the Marvad, in order to learn how to work the shiluvit program for marking bagrut. You will be marking from home, on your computer. (*NOTE- Apple computers do not work with this program).
