

Save the Environment

Everything on earth is called the **environment**. This includes everything living (ie: people and animals) and everything non-living (ie: buildings and cars).

Save the Environment

Recycling is good for the environment, for example we recycle bottles and paper. We recycle so that we don't need to cut down so many trees and so that we can protect the earth.

Global Warming



The earth is getting hotter.

The temperatures make the weather warmer.

A lot of the warming is because of pollution in the air.

How does this affect me?

This means that the icebergs are melting, the oceans have more water in them, so there are less beaches.

This also means that there aren't enough areas for animals and plants that need cool weather. This puts them in danger of extinction.
