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How to use the play?

- ✓ Pre-teach vocabulary and phonetic rules.
- ✓ Read the text aloud with expression.
- ✓ Have the students read the text aloud together [choral reading].
- Divide the class into groups. Assign each group a role.
 Each group reads aloud their part together.
- ✓ Have the students practice reading in pairs/trios.
- Assign each student a role and have them mark their part with a marker.
- The students perform the play. They read their parts aloud from the script. There is no need to memorize the lines.
- ✓ The students can use props if they want to.
