PART I: ACCESS TO INFORMATION FROM WRITTEN TEXTS (70 points)

Read the text below and then answer questions 1-7.

JACQUES COUSTEAU – A LIFE AT SEA

Most of our planet is covered by water, but we have very little knowledge of life deep in the ocean. Much of what we do know is the result of the work of one man, Jacques Cousteau. A famous film maker, inventor and ocean explorer, Cousteau spent almost 50 years on his beloved ship, the Calypso, studying and filming the world's seas.

- 5 Cousteau's films revealed strange and beautiful underwater creatures to millions of delighted viewers all over the world. He made hundreds of television documentaries and five full-length movies, three of which won the Oscar award. He also wrote many best-selling books on marine life. The first book, *The Silent World*, was translated into 22 languages and had sold more than 5 million copies by the time of Cousteau's death in 1997.

In the past there were serious problems in filming underwater, and Cousteau played an important part in solving them. In the 1940s he helped develop the aqualung, which enables divers to breathe underwater. This made it possible for his team of photographers to swim to parts of the ocean that had never been explored before.

- 15 Cousteau also designed special cameras and lights, which enabled his photographers to produce beautiful pictures of life in the ocean.

- 20 However, Cousteau's films also brought viewers the earliest pictures of the garbage that was floating on the sea. After exploring the ocean for many years, he realized that man-made pollution was causing the death of many sea creatures. Hoping to make people aware of the terrible effect of pollution, he founded the Cousteau Society for the Protection of Ocean Life. To this day, the Society promotes the conservation of the seas by organizing lectures, tours and workshops. Thanks to the work of the organization and its founder, we now have a much greater understanding of the beauty – and vulnerability – of life underwater.
